Dear Mr. Curtis:

Site CW-3, a former surface disposal area, was used to stockpile construction debris from various onsite activities. The construction debris consisted of concrete, asphalt, brick, wood and assorted scrap metals. Commencing in October of 1994, all stockpiled construction debris was shipped offsite for recycling. Said materials were sent to Mazza & Sons, Inc. which is a permitted Class B solid waste recycling facility. Cleanup of the site was completed in May of 1995.

On September 25, 1997, Directorate of Public Works (DPW) personnel, under your personal oversight, excavated 29 test pits at the former surface disposal area to ascertain whether any waste materials had been buried at the site. No waste materials were encountered within any of the test pits. The various soil horizons within each test pit were clearly undisturbed. Based upon these findings, we formally request that the Bureau of Federal Case Management issue a letter of no further action for this site.
