On December 19, 2012, the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (Department) provided comments on the December 2012 Finding of Suitability to Lease (FOSL) for Main Post Buildings 410 and 418/Homeless Shelter. The comment involved the #2 fuel underground storage tank (UST) identified as UST-411-28, for which it was indicated no response from the Department to a February 1996 closure submittal had yet been received. As this office had no record of the submittal, re-submittal was requested to allow for review and comment.

The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (Department) has reviewed the February 1996 Closure and Site Investigation Report, re-submitted by the Department of the Army. The Department concurs with the Department of the Army's request that no additional remedial action is necessary for the #2 fuel oil UST-411-28, removed in July of 1994. The determination that the remedial action is complete is based upon information in the Department's case file, the reports submitted by the Department of the Army, and the certified representations and information provided to the Department.

Conditions:

Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 58:10B-120, the Department of the Army and any other person who was liable for the cleanup and removal costs, and remains liable pursuant to the Spill Act, shall

inform the Department in writing within 14 days whenever its name or address changes. Any notices submitted pursuant to this paragraph shall reference the above case numbers and shall be sent to: Bureau of Case Assignment and Initial Notice — Case Assignment Section, 401-05H, PO Box 420, Trenton, NJ. 08625-0420.
