This notice is being given to inform the public that as part of the remediation of Fort Monmouth in the boroughs of Eatontown and Oceanport, Monmouth County, a proposal has been submitted to the New Jersey Department of Environmental Prorection (Department) to discharge to ground water in accordance with a permit issued pursuant to the provisions of the New Jersey Water Pollution Control Act, N.J.S.A. 58:10A.1 et seq., its implementing regulations the New Jersey Pollutant Discharge Elimination System, N.J.A.C. 7:14A; the Ground Water Quality Standards, N.J.A.C. 7:9C; and the Technical Requirements for Site Remediation, N.J.A.C. 7:26E. The Department's Site Remediation Program is reviewing the proposal to discharge to ground water for the purpose of remediating a contaminated site with the program interest # G000000032.

Brief description of the proposed discharge: In an effort to remediate chlorinated contaminants of concern (COCs) in groundwater, the Directorate of Public Works, US Army Garrison. Fort Monmouth, proposes to inject HRC Advanced into the subsuface. The eastern half of the Main Post is underlain by the Red Bank Formation, ranging in thickness from 20-30 feet, while the western half is underlain by the Honerstown Formation, ranging in thickness from 20-30 feet. Depth to groundwater on the Main Post is ap proximately 5 to 12 feet below grade.

The addition of HRC Advanced into the subsurface quickly undergoes fermentation producing hydrogen which serves as an electron donor in a reductive dechlorination process. The HRC is an environmentally safe, slow-release compound that provides a constant source of hydrogen for up to one year and has been proven to enhance/accelerate the anaerobic biodegradation of chlorinated COCs via reductive dehalogenation pathway.

ORC Advanced is a non-toxic, food-grade calcium oxyhydroxide that produces a controlled-release of molecular oxygen for period of up to 12 months upon hydration.

The eastern half of the Main Post is underlain by the Red Bank Formation, ranging in thickness from 20 to 30 feet, while the western half is underlain by the Honerstown Formation, ranging in thickness from 20 to 30 feet. Depth to groundwater on the Main Post is approximately 5 to 12 feet below grade.

The addition of ORC Advanced into excavations formerly containing UHOTs will increase oxygen concentrations and stimulate biological growth to remediate potential groundwater impacts associated with the discharge of Number 2 fuel oil from leaking underground storage tanks
