ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF OCEAN, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, PROHIBITING PARKING ON PRESERVED LAND OWNED OR MAINTAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP OF OCEAN

STATE OF NEW JERSEY, PROHIBITING PARKING ON PRESERVED LAND OWNED OR MAINTAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP OF OCEAN

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Ocean, in the County of Ocean, and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION I. – PURPOSE The Township of Ocean has invested, through the Ocean Township Open Space Fund, the Ocean County Natural Lands Trust and the New Jersey State Green Acres Program in the preservation of various parcels of property located throughout the Municipality. These properties have been financed through the State Green Acres Program and the County of Ocean and the Rules and Regulations governing same, require that lands purchased with such funding may not be utilized for any commercial trucks, trailers, cars, boat trailers and storage containers; and WHEREAS, it is the intention of this Ordinance to establish a violation for the parking or placement of such items on preserved land owned or maintained by the Township of Ocean and funded through the New Jersey Green Acres Program, the Ocean County Natural Lands Trust or the Township of Ocean Open Space Funds.

SECTION II. Chapter 385-14 entitled "No Parking at Anytime" shall be amended to include a new provision as follows:

C. No person or entity who owns or has possession of any motor vehicle, boat, truck, trailer or portable storage facility shall place, or park, or permit the placement or parking, of any such items, which that person or entity owns or controls, on any property located with the Township of Ocean which was purchased with Open Space Funding, Ocean County Natural Lands Trust Funds or State Green Acre Funds, unless duly designated parking facilities have been established by the Township of Ocean and approved by the entity which provided funding for such land purchase and preservation. The penalty provisions of Section B(2) shall apply to any such violations of this provision.

SECTION III. This Ordinance shall take affect after second reading and publication as required by law, and the filing of the adopted

and publication as required by law, and the filing of the adopted Ordinance with the Ocean County Planning Board.

SECTION IV. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in consistent herewith. Any section, subsection, clause, phrase, ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION V. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.
