The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers New York District and the U.S. Army Engineering and Support Center, Huntsville (USAESCH), has prepared an Action Memorandum for Parcel 70 (Building 551) at Fort Monmouth (FTMM) in Oceanport, Monmouth County, New Jersey. The U.S. Army is the lead agency for FTMM in accordance with the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act (CERCLA) and Executive Order 12580. New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) is the state support agency under the National Contingency Plan for FTMM. The purpose of the Action Memorandum is to document the U.S. Army's decision to undertake the Time Critical Removal Action (TCRA) at Parcel 70 where polychlorinated biphenyl (PCB) contaminated soil was identified in soil around Building 551. This Action Memorandum describes the TCRA selected for and performed at Parcel 70. The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection has concurred with the Army's No Further Action determination for Parcel 70.

The Action Memorandum, the associated reports, and the full public record for the Site, are available for review at the Monmouth County Library, Eastern Branch, 1001 Route 35, Shrewsbury NJ 07702. The Action Memorandum is also posted on the FTMM Environmental website (<http://www.pica.army.mil/ftmonmouth/>). The New York District invites public comment on the Action Memorandum. Written comments will be accepted during a 30-day comment period starting February 15, 2018 and ending March 16, 2018. RESOLUTION TO EXCEED THE COUNTY TAX LEVY LIMITS
AND TO ESTABLISH A CAP BANK FOR CALENDAR YEAR
2018 PER N.J.S.A. 40A:4-45.14 (INTRODUCTION)

WHEREAS, the Local Government Cap Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-4 et seq., provides that in the preparation of its annual budget, County shall limit any increase in the tax levy to 2.5%, or the cost of living adjustment set by the state at 2.50% for 2018, whichever is lower, unless authorized by resolution to increase it to 3.5% over the previous year's tax levy, subject to certain exceptions; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-45.15b provides that a County may, after adoption of a resolution by the Board of Chosen Freeholders, appropriate the difference between the amount of its actual final County tax levy and the 3.5% percentage rate, as an exception to its final County tax levy in either of the next two succeeding years; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Chosen Freeholders of the County of Monmouth finds it advisable and necessary to increase its CY 2018 tax levy by up to 3.5% over the previous year's final tax levy, in the interest of promoting the health, safety and welfare of the citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Chosen Freeholders of the County of Monmouth hereby determines that a 1.0% increase in the tax levy for said year, amounting to \$2,160,817.77 in excess of the increase in final tax levies otherwise permitted by the Local Government Cap Law, is advisable and necessary; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Chosen Freeholders of the County of Monmouth hereby determines that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final tax levy shall be retained as an exception to the final tax levy in either of the next two succeeding years.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Chosen Freeholders of the County of Monmouth, a majority of the full authorized membership of this governing body affirmatively concurring, that in the CY 2018 budget year, the final tax levy of the County of Monmouth shall, in accordance with this resolution and N.J.S.A. 40A:4-45.14, be increased by 1.0%, amounting to \$2,160,817.77, and that the CY 2018 County budget for the County of Monmouth be approved and adopted in accordance with this resolution; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final tax levy shall be retained as an exception to the final tax levy in either of the next two succeeding years; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Clerk of the Board of Chosen Freeholders sets the date, time, and place for a public hearing on this resolution. The public hearing will be held on February 22, 2018 at 5:00 p.m. prevailing time, or as soon thereafter as the matter can be considered at the Hall of Records, 1 E. Main Street, Freehold, NJ 07728, and at such time and place all persons interested be given an opportunity to be heard concerning this resolution; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Clerk of the Board of Chosen Freeholders cause copy of this resolution, as introduced, to be published in an official newspaper of the County of Monmouth; and
