The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (Department) has completed review of the referenced submittal.

Section 4.3.1 states there is no evidence petroleum products were stored on the property, however, Appendix O of the January 2007 ECP Report appears to indicate the presence of an underground fuel tank adjacent to Building 2560, located within the former sewage treatment plant area.

The tank is not included in the Appendix G, leaving its status unclear at this time. Unless the tank, former or current, has been evaluated (undergone sampling) in accordance with the applicable regulations and guidance documents, this office cannot comment as to the absence or presence of a petroleum discharge.

Section 5, ECP Parcel 34 – The narrative indicates the current proposal for ground water at Building 2567 is no further action. Although a designation of no further action was given for metals in the ground water, per the November 2011 submittal for this area of concern, approved on March 7, 2012, monitoring was to be continued until two seasonal high water table events document the source area well is below the ground water standard for TBA.
